

Notice of pipeline diversion works near Kenilworth Road, west of Berkswell

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Cadent needs to move an existing gas pipeline near the A452 (Kenilworth Road), west of Berkswell, to facilitate HS2's construction and to continue to ensure a safe and reliable gas supply.

We have now finished our preparation and vegetation clearance works and will be starting the first part of our work to move this pipeline on 22 July 2019.

What are we doing?

We will be using our existing works compound off Bradnocks Marsh Island roundabout and site access points off the A452 (Kenilworth Road) to carry out the diversion.

Work to move the pipeline will include:

- Digging a trench for the new pipeline route in land east of the A452 (Kenilworth Road)
- Welding the pipe together then installing it in the trench

There will be 24-hour security on site so we can maintain a safe working environment. Please note, there will be no on-site accommodation.

We will publish a further notice in due course to report on progress and detail the next activities planned as part of the works programme. Please visit Hs2insolihull.co.uk for updates.

How will this impact you?

While there may be some low-level noise, we do not anticipate this work will cause any disruption to local people. Construction traffic will not travel through Balsall Common.

We expect the public footpaths east of Kenilworth Road to remain open but will keep people updated if this changes.

Standard construction vehicles and equipment will be used, and all work will take place inside usual working hours. There will not be any disruption to your utilities during our works.

- 24-hour security on site

What we will do

- Make sure all construction vehicles use agreed routes
- Keep all sites safe and secure
- Inform people in advance of any changes
