A452 Kenilworth Road - roundabout construction works (Phase 5 update)

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Initial works have now started and are carried out by LM – a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.

LM will be continuing **works for the construction of the roundabout on the A452 Kenilworth Road, Berkswell** close to Park Lane. The fifth phase is to continue the central reservation works.

What to expect

30 July – further notice Single lane closures on both carriageways, 24/7, except for when full road closures are in place.

30 July : Overnight road closure on the northbound carriageway 8:00pm to 6:00am.

14 August : Overnight road closure on the northbound carriageway 8:00pm to 6:00am

15 August : Overnight road closure on the southbound carriageway 8:00pm to 6:00am

Local access for residents/businesses to be agreed with the Traffic Officer. Single lane closures during daytime hours. Our contractors may also be on site for up to one hour beforehand and after to set up and pack up the site.

Further information

Traffic management including all signage will be in erected as and when required subject to consent, site and weather conditions.

Local diversions will be clearly signposted. Access to business/properties will be maintained.

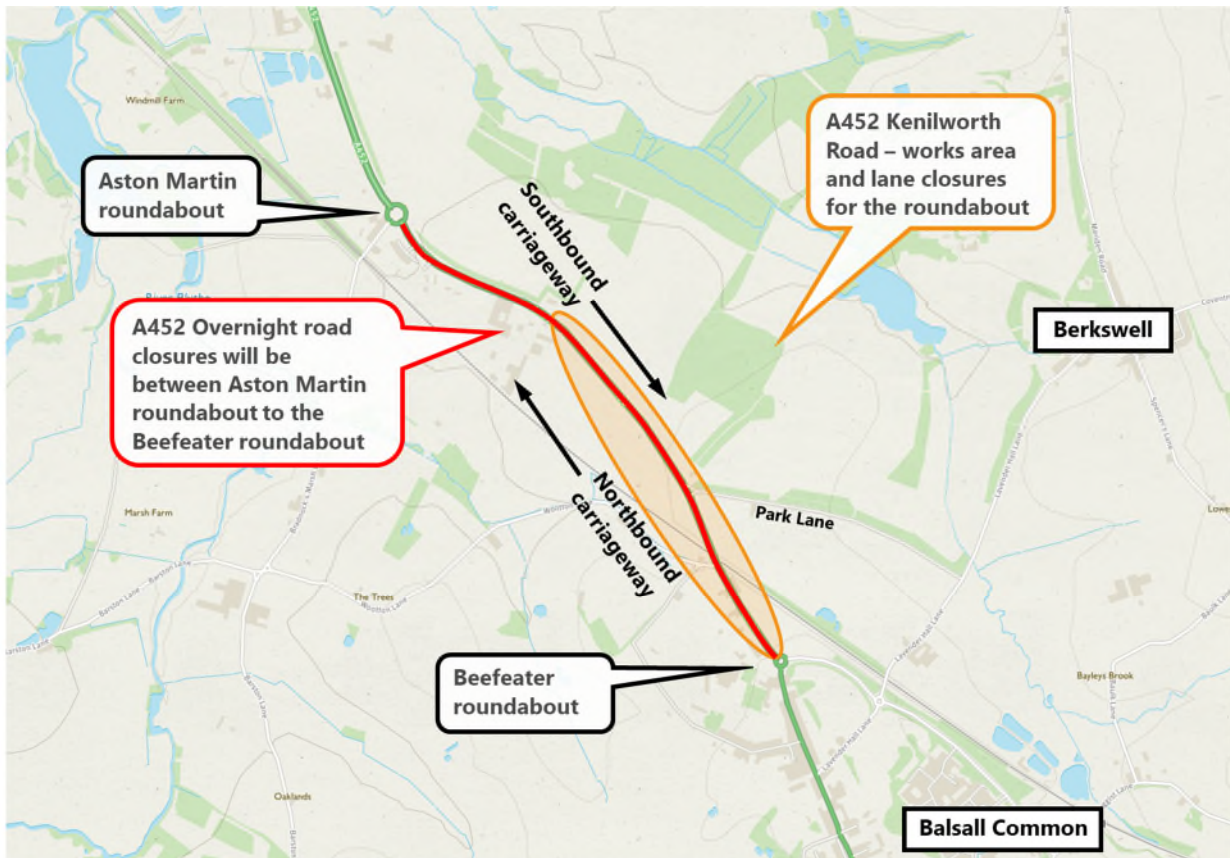

Why we are doing these works

LM are carrying out early works in preparation for the main works contractor to start building the railway. As part of the preparation for the mains work compound, which is being constructed on Park Lane, an additional roundabout is being built. This is to aid construction traffic to safely enter and exit the compound site, but also to minimise the impact of construction traffic on residents and businesses.

Additional traffic management will be required for the next phase of works and we will send further notifications about this in due course. We will also endeavour to make suitable arrangements to manage local access for businesses and residents, depending on the nature of the works, as and when required.

The planning and construction of HS2 is a huge operation – it is currently the largest infrastructure project in Europe.

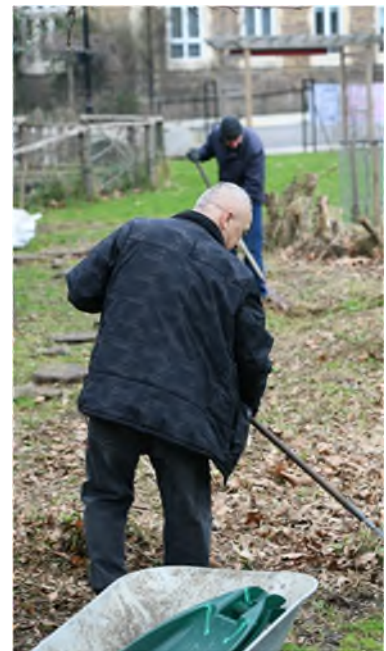
