

A452 Kenilworth Road – roundabout construction works update

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Initial works have now started and are carried out by LM – a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.



LM will soon be preparing to **restart works for the construction of the roundabout on the A452 Kenilworth Road. Berkswell. close to Park Lane.**

As with previous phases, the works over the coming months will involve a series of traffic management to be implemented on both the northbound and southbound carriageways, between the Aston Martin roundabout and the Beefeater roundabout. This is to ensure that our works can be carried out safely and allow traffic to continue to flow during the majority of our works. Park Lane will remain closed.

What to expect

Setting up a works compound at Park Lane including further vegetation clearance adjacent to the road.

Overnight closures in early June to put barriers in, with a single lane closure on each carriageway, to enable safe construction within the central reservation.

Constructing running lane for traffic will be constructed in central reservation whilst construction of the roundabout progresses.

There will then be a series of traffic management changes whilst maintaining the use of the road.

In the last phase of our works, we will require full road closures for road re-alignments and tie-ins to the new roundabout.

Our contractors may also be on site for up to one hour beforehand and after to set up and pack up the site.


What to expect

Why we are doing these works

LM are carrying out early works in preparation for the mains works contractor to start building the railway. As part of the preparation for the mains works compound, which has been constructed on Park Lane, an additional roundabout is being built. This is to aid construction traffic to safely enter and exit the compound site but also to minimise the impact of construction traffic to residents and businesses.

As stated earlier, additional traffic management will be required until the completion of our works later this year. We will send further notifications about this in due course and will endeavor to make suitable arrangements to manage local access for businesses and residents, depending on the nature of the works, as and when required.

HS2 and the COVID-19 outbreak

We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. The Government's current COVID-19 strategy makes clear that construction activity can continue as long as it complies with this guidance.
